Changing Text

After accessing the Content Editing screen using the "Edit" tab:

#1. Enter your text into the form fields. The editor provides a range of features depending on the intention of the form. Place the mouse point above the button and wait "Mouse Over" for a description of what each button does.

#2 Body text can be copied from office documents. However for consistency very little formatting is usually best. If you find yourself trying to clean up content pasted from an office document, copy the content into a text editor (e.g. notepad) first to remove any unwanted formatting.

#3. Push save. Unless you push save, your changes won't be kept on the system.


You will be returned to your newly updated version of the page.

Opportunity
Publish an *opportunity*, eg Education Opportunity, Student Opportunity, Position Vacant etc

Webform
Create a new form or questionnaire accessible to users. Submission results and statistics are recorded and accessible to privileged users.

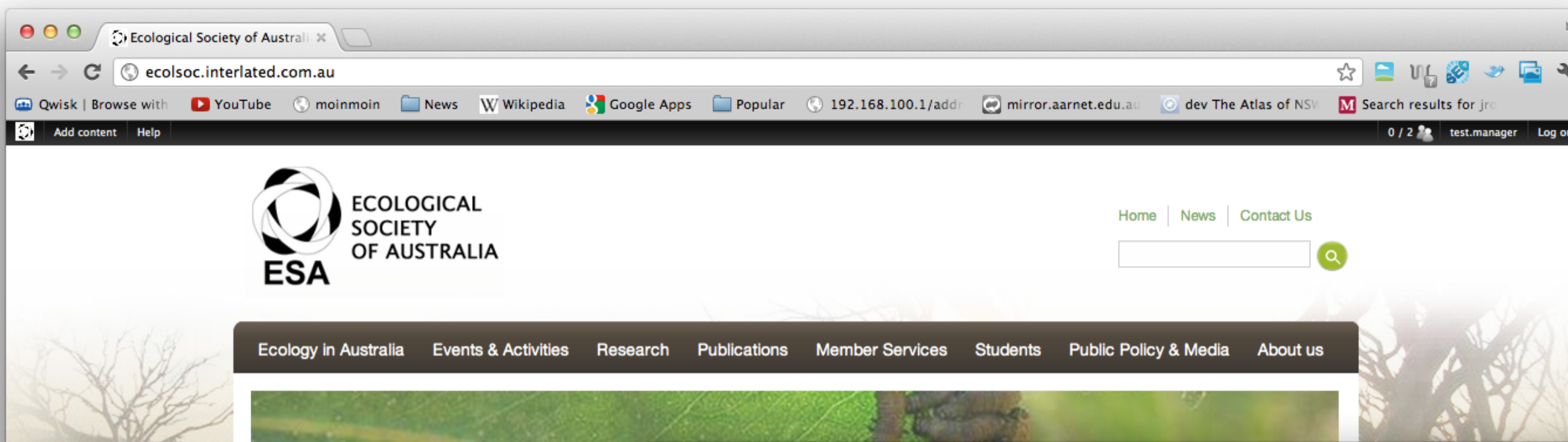

 #4 Images can be loaded into the content area. The image that is used for thumbnails (#6) is uploaded here. The system will scale the image, but smaller images are faster to upload.
 #5 Don't forget to to push "Save". This will add your work to the site and all indexes.

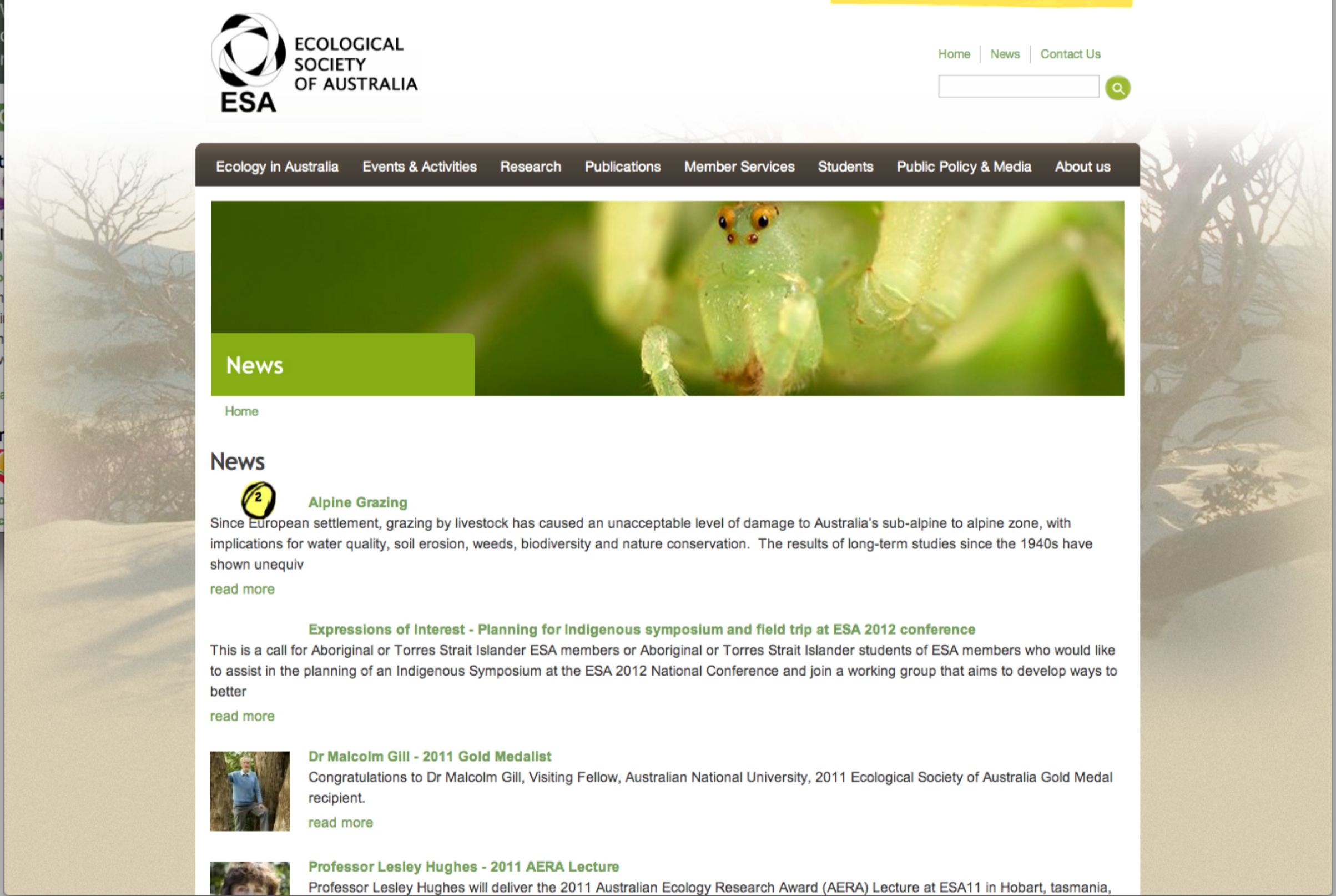
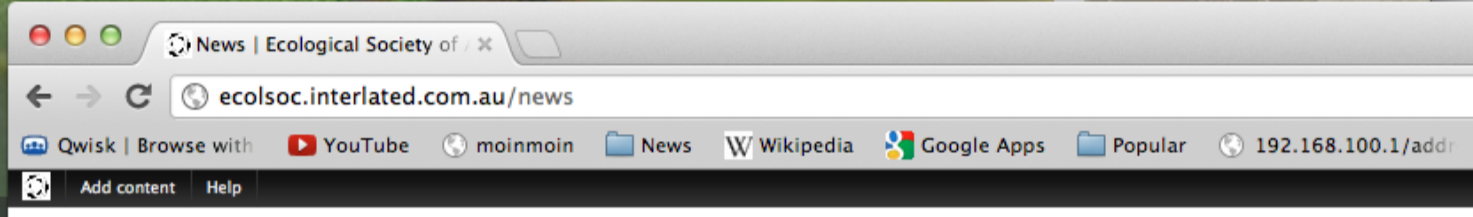
